Even if the electric is off perhaps you can communicate via cell phone. We find Beach 104.1 (Radio Station) is very helpful during emergencies, with their broadcast. Perhaps a call to them would be a good way to see what is happening in your area. It worked for some during the last storm. A neighbor however is the best way.

If you have yard debris and have called Town Hall for pick-up, great. They are just backlogged with Matthew debris. If you have not called, please call 252-441-1122 and get on the list. This also includes old furniture, appliances, etc. but NOT construction material. And if you have broken electronics you can take those to the 8th Street drop-off yard on Lark Street. Hours of operation are Monday, 9-3:30, Thursday 9-3:30, and Saturday 9-3. You do need a Town sticker but there is no charge for it.



Don't forget it is nearing time to winterize your home if you are going to be away during the winter. We do have some neighbors that discover frozen pipes and when they thaw you can have not only a huge water bill but possibly some damage.

Our dues are increased by \$15.00 annually and this will be reflected in your May billing. A MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

Back in the summer our Board decided to write the Town, to request the continuation of the Westside sidewalk adjacent to the by-pass. When the Town began the sidewalk in 2008 the purpose was connectivity of the Westside neighborhoods. So far this has connected all neighborhoods north of the Cove, to Hollowell Street. Then you can ride (or walk) over to the multi-use path on the beach road until you reach Danube where you meet with the sidewalk that runs west to Danube. We would like to see the continuation of the sidewalk along the by-pass, past Old Nags Head Cove to the Mall and eventually to the Village at Nags Head, connecting finally, the two largest Westside neighborhoods. In response to our request we were told there are no funds set aside for the sidewalk due to the fact the Town is concentrating on Dowdy's Park. While we certainly understand this, and that is a huge undertaking as well as an expensive one, what we wanted was to be assured when sidewalk funds were available again, the sidewalk would begin at the Cove and run south.

If this is of interest to you we ask that you contact your Town Commissioners and Mayor to request the continuation of the sidewalk when funds become available. In the past the Tourism Board has been very generous so we can hope another grant could be forthcoming in the future. While the budget is set for the 2016-2017 fiscal year it is never too early to press on for a project. This would benefit not only the year round population in our neighborhood but also the summer visitors and all ages.
